WHEREAS, textbooks not exchanged or given away will be recycled or discarded appropriately; and

WHEREAS, with the update of the Destiny textbook inventory programs at all our secondary schools, many texts have been identified which are no longer adopted or in use in our classrooms; and

WHEREAS, the Educational Services department maintains a file listing the names and numbers of the K-12 books which are now unusable or obsolete;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the district may discard all textbooks and support materials as indicated above.
