**Resolution Declaring Certain Textbooks Unusable or Obsolete**

*WHEREAS*, district-owned instructional materials have been replaced by more recent versions or editions of the same material and are of no foreseeable value in other instructional areas, these textbooks may be declared unusable, obsolete, and no longer needed by the Board of Education; and

*WHEREAS*, schools currently have many of these obsolete books in their inventory, and they wish to be able to dispose of them by either giving them to a nonprofit charitable organization or trading these books in for textbook credit through a used textbook distributor; and

*WHEREAS*, textbooks not exchanged or given away will be recycled or discarded appropriately; and

*WHEREAS*, with the update of the Destiny textbook inventory programs at all our secondary schools, many texts have been identified which are no longer adopted or in use in our classrooms; and

*WHEREAS*, the Educational Services department maintains a file listing the names and numbers of the K-12 books which are now unusable or obsolete;

*THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED*, that the district may discard all textbooks and support materials as indicated above.
