WHEREAS, in November of 1979, the California electorate did adopt Proposition 4, commonly called the Gann Amendment, which added Article XIIIB to the California Constitution, and;

WHEREAS, the provisions of the Article establish maximum appropriation limitations, commonly called Gann Limits, for public agencies, including school districts, and;

WHEREAS, the district must recalculate the Gann Limit for FY13-14and establish the FY14-15 estimated Gann Limit in accordance with the provisions of Article XIIIB and applicable statutory law:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the calculations and documentation of the Gann Limit for the 2013-14 and 2014-15 fiscal years are made in accordance with the applicable constitutional and statutory law;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Board does hereby declare that the appropriations in the budget for 2013-14 and 2014-15 fiscal years do not exceed the limitations imposed by Proposition 4.
