**Certification of Requirement of Education Code Section 60119 for Sufficiency of
Pupil Textbooks and Instructional Materials Incentive Program**

WHEREAS, the Governing Board of Alameda City Unified School District, in order to comply with the requirements of Education Code section 60119, held a public hearing on October 14, 2014, at approximately 7:00 pm, which is on or before the eighth week of school and which did not take place during or immediately following school hours; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Board provided at least 10 days notice of the public hearing posted in at least three public places within the district that stated the time, place, and purpose of the hearing, and;

WHEREAS, the Governing Board encouraged participation by parents, teachers, members of the community, and bargaining unit leaders in the public hearing; and

WHEREAS, information provided at the public hearing and to the Governing Board at the public meeting detailed the extent to which textbooks and instructional materials were provided to all students, including English learners, in the district/county office of education; and

WHEREAS, the definition of “sufficient textbooks or instructional materials” means that each pupil has textbook or instructional materials, or both, to use in class and to take home; and

WHEREAS, between the 2008-09 through 2014-15 fiscal years, the definition of “sufficient textbooks or instructional materials” also means that all students who are enrolled in the same course within the Alameda Unified School District, have standards-aligned textbooks or instructional materials from the same adoption cycle; and

WHEREAS, sufficient textbooks and instructional materials were provided to each student, including English learners, which are aligned to the academic content standards and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks within the following subjects:

- Mathematics
- Science
- History-social science
- English/language arts, including the English language development component of an adopted program; and

WHEREAS, sufficient textbooks or instructional materials were provided to each pupil enrolled in foreign language or health classes; and

WHEREAS, laboratory science equipment was available for science laboratory classes offered in grades 9-12, inclusive;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that for the 2014 - 2015 school year, the Alameda Unified School District has provided each pupil with sufficient textbooks and instructional materials aligned to the academic content standards and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks.
