## Approval of Wood Middle School Field Lighting Project Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration

WHEREAS, the District has prepared an Initial Study regarding the potential impacts of the planned project to install directed lights at one baseball field at Wood Middle School (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Initial Study concluded that there is no substantial evidence that the Project will have a significant effect on the environment, and that the District should adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration and proceed with the Project; and

WHEREAS, consistent with section 15072, title 14 of the California Code of Regulations, on August 28, 2014, the District issued a Notice of Intent to Adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration, published said notice in a newspaper of general circulation, direct mailed copies of the notice to occupants of properties adjacent to the Project site, and provided a copy of such notice to the Alameda County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration was presented to the community by the District at the August 27<sup>th</sup>, 2014 Board of Education meeting, and the District accepted public comments on the Project and Initial Study during the period of August 28<sup>th</sup> – October 6, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the public comments received during that period are maintained at the District's offices, located at 2060 Challenger Drive, Alameda, CA, ATTN: Chief Business Officer; and

WHEREAS, the District conducted a public hearing on the Mitigated Negative Declaration on September 23, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the District has considered the proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration together with the comments received during the public review process, and finds on the basis of the whole record before it (including the initial study and the comments received), that there is no substantial evidence that the Project will have a significant effect on the environment and that the Mitigated Negative Declaration reflects its independent judgment and analysis

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board approves the Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration.
