On June 24, the Board took action to conduct a community/public conversation about the future of the two comprehensive high schools in AUSD.



Staff is presenting a draft timeline for community engagement on the issue of AUSD's high schools for Board review and direction.



Proposal – October 14, 2014

- Board of Education Meeting
- Roll out the process
- Board provides input and direction on proposal
- Once proposal is approved, staff will begin to research, including on the size and space needs of one high school, high school configurations in other districts, land availability, and demographic projections.



Proposal – November 18, 2014

- Board of Education Meeting
- Bond election results and next steps
- Outline options of projects for elementary and middle schools
- Provide update on high school research to date



Proposal – Two Community Meetings

- January 22, 2015 at Wood Middle School
 - Introduction to issue
 - Presentation of proposed question of two high schools or combine into one comprehensive high school
 - Discussion/input
 - Questions for staff to answer
- February 5, 2015 at Lincoln Middle School
 - Return with answers to questions from Meeting #1
 - Begin narrowing to a possible solution

- Board Study Session
- Board and community have the opportunity to discuss the concept in public
- Give input to staff



Proposal – February 24, 2015

- Board of Education Meeting
- Presentation of research, community meeting discussions, Board study session
- Staff recommendation to Board



Proposal – March 10, 2015

- Board of Education Meeting
- Board action to approve the concept proposed by staff







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
