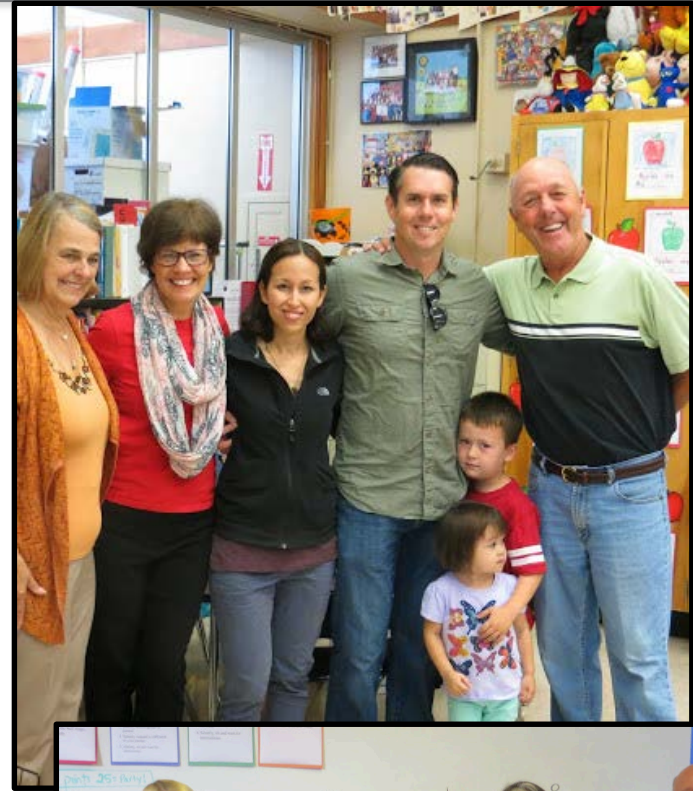

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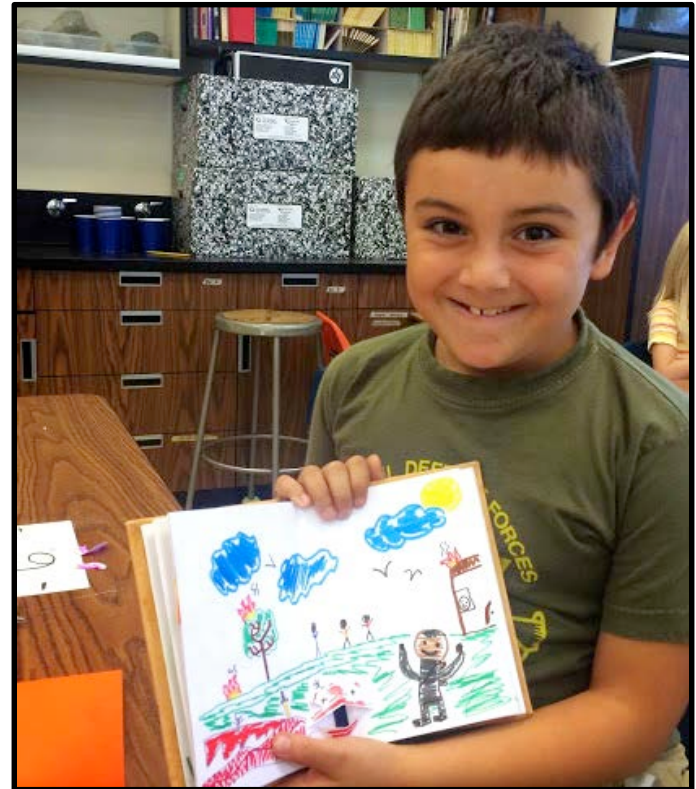

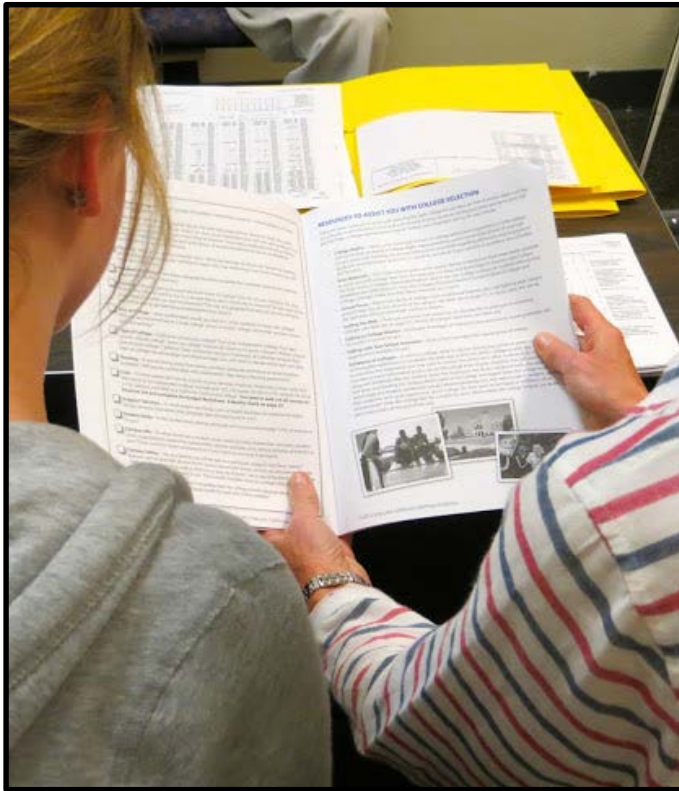

## College Readiness and Graduation Requirements

- 5 credits in Current Life
- 75 Elective credits
- 20 credits total:
  - 10 credits in World Language
  - 10 credits in Visual Performing Arts
  - 10 credits of Career Technical Education (CTE) may be substituted for world language or visual performing arts

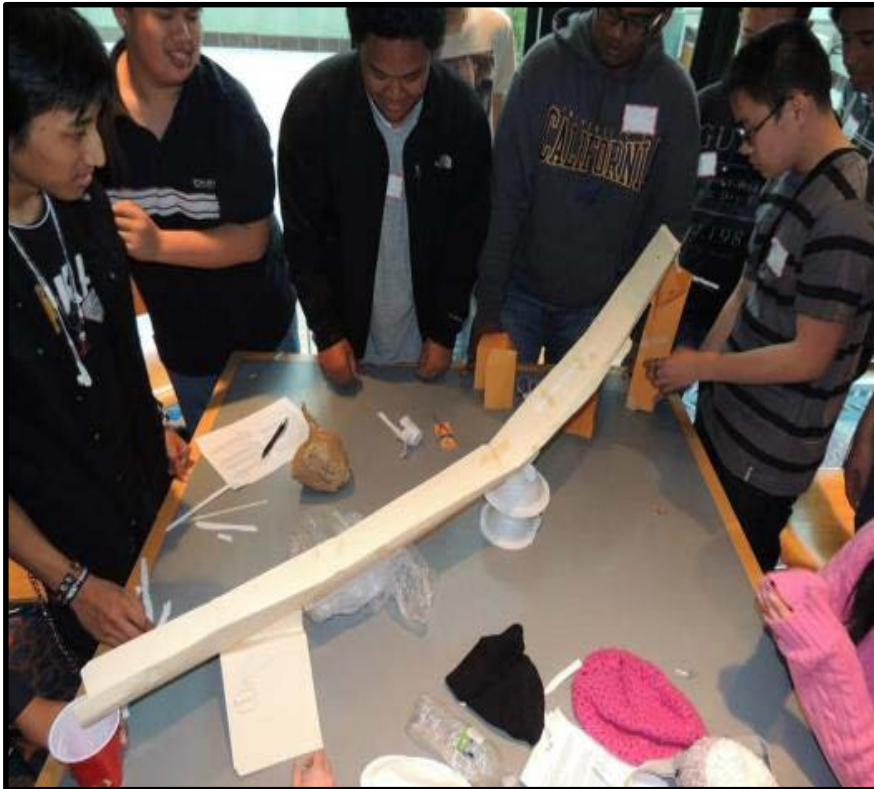
