I believe this current school board will influence education for all of Alameda for the next 25-50 years. It will select our next Superintendent^{*;} choose the capital projects needed across the District that will be funded by our new parcel tax; develop a plan to reward our teachers with a pay that is comparable to the average teacher's pay across all of Alameda County; and develop the structure and amount of the next parcel tax needed to replace our current parcel tax.

I've been an advocate of removing the disparity of resources between different schools across


