

CONSOLIDATING ENCINAL HIGH SCHOOL AND JUNIOR JETS UNDER ONE CDS CODE



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BACKGROUND

- Junior Jets was opened in 2013-14 as an innovative program with a unique CDS code.
- A stand-alone middle school, Junior Jets, became eligible to receive Title I funding.
- Duplication of efforts in many areas became apparent during the 2013-2014 inaugural year that were caused by working under two CDS codes.

CHALLENGES

- A single 6-12 school would resolve the following challenges:
 - Two Master Schedules
 - Two Report Cards
 - Two Student Data Bases
 - Two School Loop Sites
 - Two SARCs
 - Two Emergency Plans

CHALLENGES (CONT'D)

- Two Budgets
- Two websites
- Two different phone numbers for the school
- Two transcripts for students with concurrent enrollment
- Two SSCs and School Plans (SPSAs)

RECOMMENDATION

- Junior Jets Staff and Community recommend that the School Board approve a plan to consolidate Encinal High School and Junior Jets under one CDS code.
- This change will:
 - Eliminate duplicate systems
 - Allow for more streamlined staffing, systems and communication with all stakeholders
 - Increase the efficiency of our work at all levels

HOME OF THE JETS AND JUNIOR JETS

- ▶ **Represents consolidation of schools without losing the history of the school**
- ▶ **Research of 6-12 schools in California showed this to be a standard name configuration**
