Board Policy 5111 - Admission

The Board of Education encourages parents, students and staff to enroll and appropriately place all school-aged children in school. The Superintendent or designee shall inform parents/guardians of students entering a district school at any grade level about admission requirements and shall assist them with enrollment procedures.

The Superintendent or designee shall verify the student's age, residency, and any other admission criteria specified in law and in Board policies and administrative regulations. The Superintendent or designee may admit foreign students who have fulfilled the US Government requirements for study for grades 9-12.

Consistent with the law, the Superintendent or designee shall promulgate an administrative regulation designed to remove barriers to educational success imposed on children of out-of-state military families due to the frequent moves and deployment of their parents. Such regulation shall take effect when approved by the Board and terminate on April 30, 2017.

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All resident students who are enrolling either in the school in their attendance area or in another district school shall be subject to the timelines established by the Board in BP/AR 5116.1 - Intradistrict Open Enrollment. Nonresident students may apply for interdistrict attendance in accordance with the timelines specified in applicable Board policies and administrative regulations.
