Multi-Tiered Systems of Support

Preventative approach applied across three tiers of intervention.

Identify who needs support as early as possible; implement supports when needed; and determine if those supports are effective.

- Prevent development of new problems
- Reduce the number of existing challenges
- Reduce the intensity and complexity of needed supports


Bringing it all together - Classroom Teachers
