

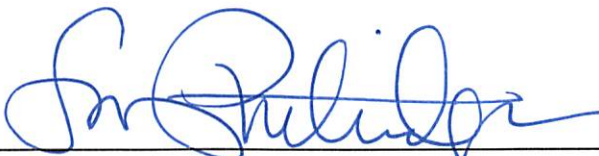
MEMORANDUM

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN THE
CALIFORNIA SCHOOL EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, CHAPTER 860 AND THE
ALAMEDA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT**

Salary Reclass for Maintenance Trades Positions

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered into between the California School Employees Association, Chapter 860 (CSEA #860) and the Alameda Unified School District (District) for the purpose of outlining the identified positions and ranges to receive a salary reclassification.

The MOU has come as a result of the last year, the District operated without any electrical and HVAC technicians and with partial staffing in plumbing and carpentry. As a result the District has had to contract this work to outside vendors. These contracts have resulted in higher costs to the District as well as delayed work.

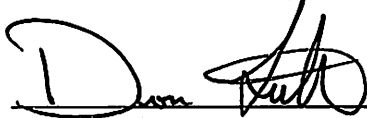
The District has completed a desk audit for these specific positions and proposes the reclassification and salary range modification as follows:

Position	Current Range	Proposed Range
Carpenter, Electrician, Painter, Heating Ventilation (HVAC), and Plumber	52	59
Leads for Carpenter, Electrician, Painter, Heating Ventilation (HVAC), and Plumber	56	63
Maintenance Operation Lead (currently not in use) Custodial Operation Lead	60	66

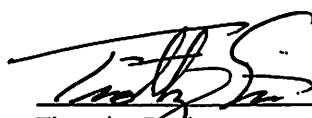

The parties agree that these salary reclassifications shall become effective on the month following the ratification of both parties.

Upon signing this MOU both parties agree to follow their procedures for approval and implementation. This MOU is entered into by the parties on May 3, 2019. This MOU applies only to the reclassification of the specified positions and does not establish any contractual precedent.
