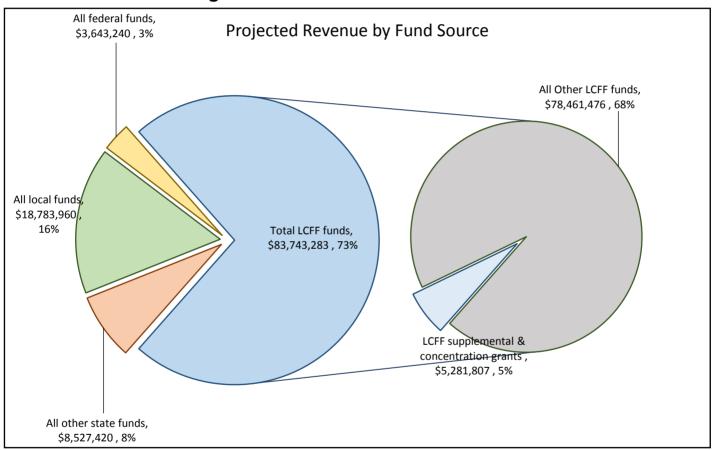

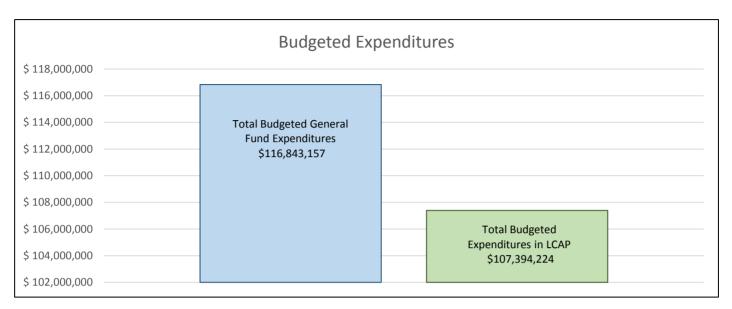


This chart shows the total general purpose revenue Alameda Unified expects to receive in the coming year from all sources.

The total revenue projected for Alameda Unified is \$114,697,903.00, of which \$83,743,283.00 is Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF), \$8,527,420.00 is other state funds, \$18,783,960.00 is local funds, and \$3,643,240.00 is federal funds. Of the \$83,743,283.00 in LCFF Funds, \$5,281,807.00 is generated based on the enrollment of high needs students (foster youth, English learner, and low-income students).

This chart provides a quick summary of how much Alameda Unified plans to spend for 2019-20. It shows how much of the total is tied to planned actions and services in the LCAP.

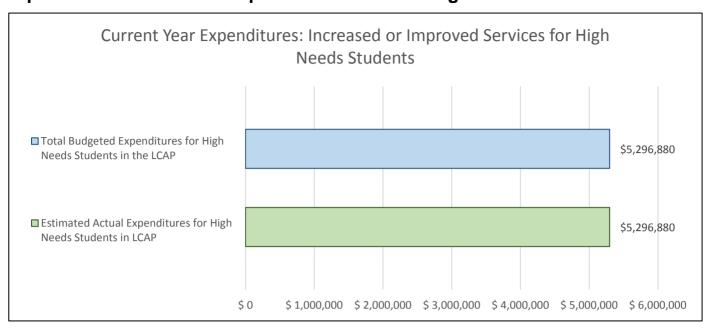
Alameda Unified plans to spend \$116,843,157.00 for the 2019-20 school year. Of that amount, \$107,394,224.00 is tied to actions/services in the LCAP and \$9,448,933.00 is not included in the LCAP. The budgeted expenditures that are not included in the LCAP will be used for the following:

Transportation, Indirect costs, Superintendent's budget, Board and \$4M on behalf contribution Increased or Improved Services for High Needs Students in 2019-20

In 2019-20, Alameda Unified is projecting it will receive \$5,281,807.00 based on the enrollment of foster youth, English learner, and low-income students. Alameda Unified must demonstrate the planned actions and services will increase or improve services for high needs students compared to the services all students receive in proportion to the increased funding it receives for high needs students. In the LCAP, Alameda Unified plans to spend \$5,497,698.00 on actions to meet this requirement.
