- Programs



- Student & Teacher Support



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Enrichment After-School Classes

- Provides learning opportunities that are not included in the regular school day
- Exposes students to new subject areas
- Supports student engagement
- ~2,000 students per year
- Grades K-8 (primarily)
- 200 classes per year
- 11 campuses (Fall 2019)
- Art, music, foreign language, STEM



programs

Enrichment Summer Camps

- Provides in-depth, hands-on learning
- 600+ students per year
- Grades K – 8
- 50+ week-long camps/5 weeks
- Art, music, foreign language, STEM
- After-care
- Internship Program for teens



programs

Middle School Sports

- Instills the values of team work and sportsmanship
- Supports academic and behavioral standards
- Helps prepare students for high school
- Over 600 participants, 6th – 8th grade
- AUSD and charter schools
- Volleyball, basketball, track & field
- Jack Capon award

Robotics

- Translates STEM principles into hands-on learning in an engaging way
- 120 students (2019), 4th – 8th graders
- 19 teams, 9 schools
- Lego MindStorm NXT
- Largely student run

College Prep Academy

- Promotes equity via focus on students who are underrepresented in college
- 100+ students/year
- SAT test prep courses & Personal Statement workshops

Art Across the Island

- Fosters visual arts and creative writing skills
- Creates avenues for expressing feelings & ideas
- 1,000+ of pieces of art per year in a revolving showcase at venues throughout Alameda
- All AUSD schools, heavy Title I
- Art Beyond Our Island

Equipped 4 Success

- 800 -1,000 students per year
- New teacher support
- Partnership with AUSD and nonprofits
- Community support

- Focus on new teachers and low-income schools
- 170 – 190 teachers per year
- \$500 donations
- Community engagement
