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# Fall Planning

- Goal for 21-22 will be to reopen as full as is permissible/possible in Fall with in-person instruction K-12
- Limited remote school options are being developed (largely based on current models)

 Potentially narrowed to those families with demonstrable medical needs and vulnerabilities (exploring this at present)

- Remote school staffing complexities mean COMBINATION classes extremely likely in both remote and in-person classes
- Librarians/media center teachers, music teachers, PE and all specialist teachers will return to 19-20 assignments (will not be used to round out classes or eliminate combos)

- Staffing will consider subject matter at secondary for content-specific support
- Elementary model will essentially be this year's distance learning model (adjustments being explored)
- Secondary model Edgenuity + Subject Matter Support (GOAL)

# Fall Planning

- Shifts in distancing
- Lower physical distancing policies can be adopted in school settings with masking mandates without negatively impacting student or staff safety.
- Among more than 240 school districts studied, Covid-19 case rates were similar whether the districts required physical distancing of 3 feet or 6 feet.
- Journal Clinical Infectious Diseases

CDC expected to update guidance on physical distancing in schools soon.
