WHEREAS, due to lack of work and/or lack of funds, this Board hereby finds that it is in the best interests of the Alameda Unified School District that effective the 30th day of July 2021, or as soon thereafter as possible, as determined by the Superintendent, certain services now being provided by said school district be discontinued as follows; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Superintendent, or designee, of the Alameda Unified School District is authorized and directed to give a notice of layoff to one (2) classified employees of the school district pursuant to District rules and regulations and applicable provisions of the Education Code of the State of California no later than sixty (60) days prior to the effective date of layoff as set forth above.
