

Board Approved Project Costs

Costs are all inclusive *Project Costs* including:

- Non-Construction Costs including Change Order Contingency, DSA, Testing, Design, Inspection, etc. (30%)
- Contractors mark ups, Bonds & Insurance
- Design contingency (20%)
- Bidding contingency due to the current volatile bidding market (10%)
- Escalation Contingency to the mid-point of 2026

Encinal High School

- New gymnasium

 - Stage (including MPR's stage)
 - > Lighting
 - Dressing rooms
 - Seating
- Modernization of 500 Wing classrooms
- Synthetic all-weather field, track, and bleachers



Alameda High School

- Modernization of Building A & B
- Outdoor Learning Areas
- Synthetic all-weather field and bleachers
 - Location to be finalized
- > Swimming Pool
 - ➤ In partnership with the City of Alameda (\$7.5M allowance)
- Kofman Auditorium (\$3M allowance)
 - Sound system
 - Stage lighting (limited to existing infrastructure)
 - Dressing rooms



- > Lighting improvements
- > Student drop-off area
- Outdoor learning spaces



Criteria for Sequencing of Facilities Projects

- Physical condition of buildings
- Compliance issues (swimming pool*)
- > Seismic needs
- Student capacity constraints
- Schools using temporary housing
- > Level of ventilation
- ➤ Availability of green space

Projects – In Planning

- > WCDC and Island High at the Longfellow campus (measure I)
- > Wood Middle School
 - Decision on location of Alameda High field
- ➤ Alameda High swimming pool
 - ➤ Initial work by a City and School District committee
 - ➤ Community input sessions in fall 2022
- > Kofman theater
 - > Initial input by secondary school staff
 - ➤ Community input sessions in fall 2022
- Safety & Security committee

Measure B Oversight Committee

- ➤ Measure B is a proposition 39 bond and requires a citizens' bond oversight committee
- > Attracting members for oversight committees is challenging
- Option to appoint Measure I oversight committee members to Measure B
 - Continuity from Measure I
 - > Two separate committees, separate agendas, same members
