

History of the Current Name

- Woodstock Child Development Center established in 1943.
- Named after the "Woodstock" neighborhood, one of three original settlements in Alameda.
- Originally housed at Singleton site, then moved to Longfellow site.

Step 1: Name Review Trigger



Board interest in naming WCDC after Board Member Dailey

AR 7310 calls for review of name if:

- Petition signed by 25 percent enrolled students **or**
- Petition signed by parents/guardians of at least 25 percent enrolled students **or**
- Petition signed by at least 50% of school's employees (PT and FT) **or**
- Board calls for review **or**
- Superintendent calls for a review



Steps 2 & 3: Review and Recommend

Step 2: Is the name appropriate?

- If named after geographic area, has the name become outdated?
- Hold 3 school community meetings
 - \circ Students
 - o **Employees**
 - $_{\circ}$ Families of students



Step 3: Superintendent recommends renaming to Board



Steps 4 & 5: Committee & Community

Step 4: Convene Renaming Committee

• Representatives from certificated and non- certificated staff, students, parents/guardians, alumni groups, and school community (e.g., members of business or neighborhood organizations and civic officials).

Step 5: Hold Community Meetings

- **Meeting 1**: Alert the community that a naming process has begun
- Meeting 2: Solicit potential names
- Meeting 3: Receive feedback on the potential names the committee is considering



Steps 6 & 7: Survey & Name Submission

Step 6: Committee conducts survey of school community, providing minimum of 2 names and maximum of 5 names.

Step 7: If school community approves a new name, the committee votes to recommend the name to the Superintendent.







Steps 8-10: Recommendation to Board, Public Comment, Board Vote

- **Step 8:** Superintendent recommends name to Board
- **Step 9:** 60-Day public comment period
- Step 10: Board vote





<u>Timeline</u>

- Possible to complete by mid-December
- New name can be officially implemented in 2023-24 (CDE).
