Adoption of 2014-15 and 2015-16 Gann Limit

Resolution No. 2015-2016.11

WHEREAS, in November of 1979, the California electorate did adopt Proposition 4, commonly called the Gann Amendment, which added Article XIII B to the California Constitution; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of the Article establish maximum appropriation limitations, commonly called Gann Limits, for public agencies, including school districts; and

WHEREAS, the district must recalculate the Gann Limit for FY14-15 and establish the FY15-16 estimated Gann Limit in accordance with the provisions of Article XIII B and applicable statutory law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the calculations and documentation of the Gann Limit for the 2014-15 and 2015-16 fiscal years are made in accordance with the applicable constitutional and statutory law;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Board does hereby declare that the appropriations in the budget for 2014-15 and 2015-16 fiscal years do not exceed the limitations imposed by Proposition 4.
