# ALAMEDA CITY UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT APPLICATION FOR INDEPENDENT CITIZENS' BOND OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

The Board of Education of the Alameda City Unified School District is seeking four (4) qualified, interested individuals to serve on a committee of community leaders which will serve as the Independent Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee (BOC) for the implementation of the District's Measure I school facilities bond program. The six (6) member committee consists of members representing the following constituencies: Business Representative, Senior Citizen, Taxpayer Organization Member, Parent or Guardian of Child Enrolled in District, Parent or Guardian of Child Enrolled in District & Active in a Parent-Teacher Organization and an At-Large Community Member. Currently the District is looking for the following four (4) members: Business Representative (local business), Senior Citizen, Parent (child currently enrolled in AUSD), and Taxpayer Organization Member (bona fide taxpayer's association).

## **Proposition 39 Bond Election**

On November 4, 2014, voters residing within the Alameda City Unified School District passed Measure I. Measure I is a \$179,500,000 bond measure that authorizes funding for needed repairs, upgrades, and new construction projects to the District's schools. Proposition 39 required a 55% supermajority for approval; Measure I was passed by 61.41%.

## **Establishment of a Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee**

After a bond authorized under Proposition 39 is passed, state law requires that the Alameda City Unified School District Board appoint an Independent Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee to work with the District.

# **Committee Responsibilities**

In accordance with Education Code Section 15278(b), the Citizens' Oversight Committee shall:

- Inform the public concerning the District's expenditure of Measure I bond proceeds;
- Review expenditure reports produced by the District to ensure that Measure I bond proceeds were expended only for the purposes set forth in Measure I; and
- Present to the Board in public session, an annual written report outlining their activities and conclusions regarding the expenditure of Measure I bond proceeds.

# **Appointment of Committee Members**

All appointments will be made by the Board from applications submitted to the District.

#### **Time Commitment and Term**

Committee appointments will be appointed to serve a one or two-year term.
