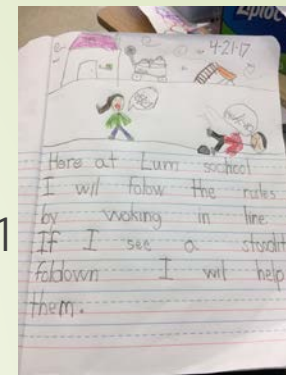

- Added .5 FTE Lead Interventionist
- Continued .2 FTE Behaviorist, paid through site SPSA funds
- “Beary good” awards and Friday prize drawings
- Monthly character award winners

# Flexible learning environments

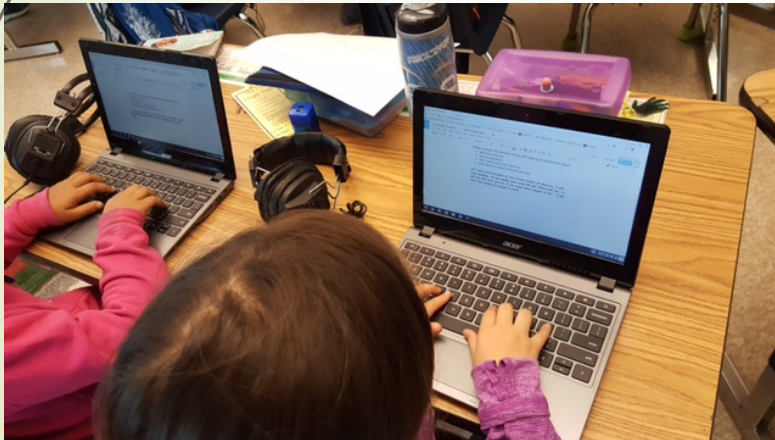
- Flexible seating introduced to Lum!

# ELD program

- 135 EL students, 28% of school
- 169 students speak from 38 non-English languages, 35% of school
- New ELD coach
- Continued 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> grade rotations
- Added 3<sup>rd</sup> grade rotations
- Added 4<sup>th</sup>/5<sup>th</sup> systematic ELD time
- Piloted new ELD assessment ELPAC – English Language Proficiency Assessments for CA





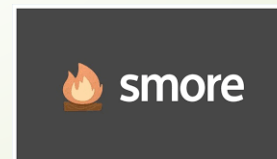
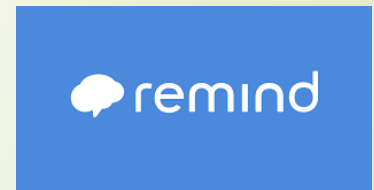

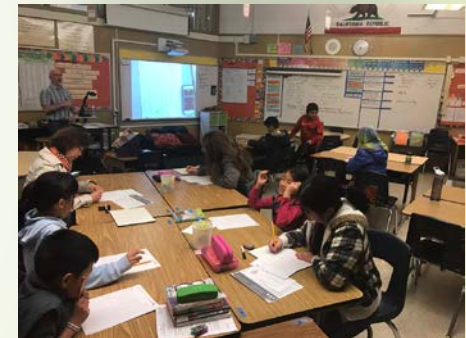


# Empowering parents
