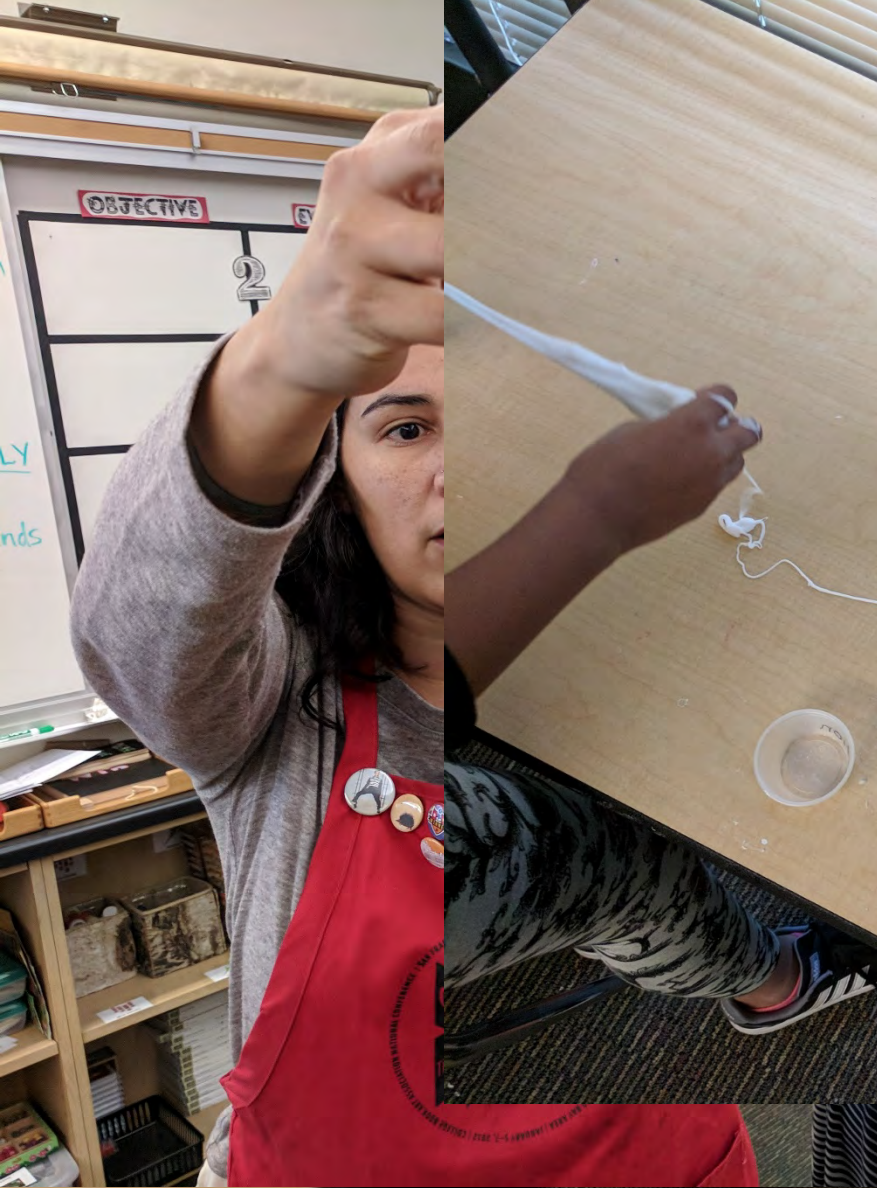
Students come in every other week for hour lesson in room 401 with AUSD Teacher of the Year Mandie Cline.

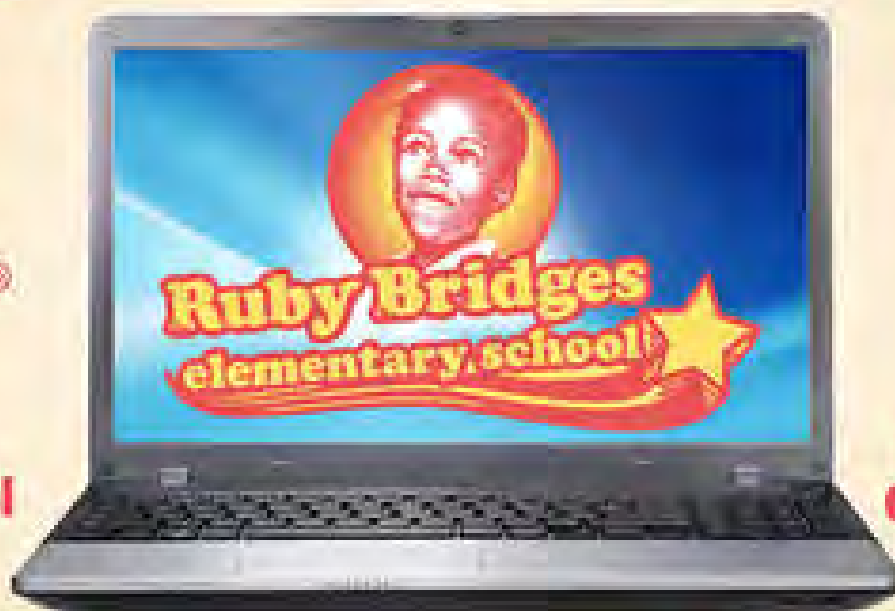

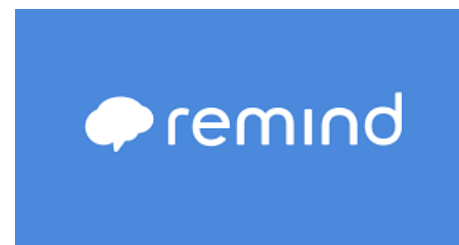
