Measure A Basics

- Approved by 68.01% of voters in 2011
- \$12 million in revenue per year
- Sunsets in June 30, 2018
- Measure B1 begins July 1, 2018 and extends until July 1, 2015.

Measure A Accounting

- Expenditures are limited to 11 specific categories, plus oversight & accountability.
- Tracking system includes separate budget codes and separate funds.
- Measure A Oversight Committee reviews revenues and expenditures to ensure compliance.



Three Reports Per Year

- Annual report on revenues and expenditures for previous year
- Second interim budget report for the current year
- Recommended expenditures for the next year

<u>Three Primary Points About</u> <u>This Year's Staff Report</u>

- AUSD remains highly reliant on the \$12 million collected per year via Measure A. It is the second-largest stream of revenue coming into the district.
- 2. Measure A has among the highest levels of oversight for any parcel tax in the State.
- 3. This is the last year of Measure A. Measure B1 begins in July, 2018.

Adult Education Allocation

Under Board Policy 3221, AUSD's Board of Education can make changes in Measure A allocations in the event of "severe fiscal emergency" or "changed funding circumstances."

In 2015, the State re-funded Adult Education, which resulted in AUSD receiving a \$480,000 Adult Education Block Grant. Staff recommended that the funds allocated to that category be re-distributed to the three largest Measure A programs:

Attracting and retaiingn excellent teachers Programs to close the achievement gap Small K-3 class sizes

The Board of Education approved this on October 27, 2015

Next Steps

- 2017-18 Measure A Oversight Committee begins meeting in February, 2018.
- 2nd interim 2017-18 report, as well as recommendations for 2018-19 expenditures, will be presented this spring.
- Measure A sunsets June 31, 2018.
- Measure B1 goes into effect July 1, 2018.
