# Diversion Policy

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Students will be diverted in the following order:

1. Students attending the school on an interdistrict transfer (living outside of Alameda).
2. Intradistrict transfer (living inside Alameda in a different school zone) students with a space at their home school who do not fall into categories below and or have been at the school less than 1 year and 19 days.
3. Students residing in the school's attendance zone and/or whose parent/guardian is assigned to that school as his/her primary place of employment. Within this group, students will be moved in reverse order of enrollment date.
4. Students residing in the school's attendance zone and/or whose parent/guardian is assigned to that school as his/her primary place of employment that have a sibling who attended that school the year prior. Within this group, students will be moved in reverse order of enrollment date.

# Diversion Policy

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Students who are diverted to a school outside their home school attendance zone will be offered the opportunity to return to their home school if space becomes available. The order of return will be based on enrollment date.

A student who is diverted may not be involuntarily re-diverted into a third school. The District shall re-designate the diversion site as the diverted student's home school if either:

- The student's parent/guardian so requests, or
- The student's parent/guardian declines offers to return the student to his/her home school in multiple school years.

If the diversion site is re-designated as the diverted student's home school, the student's family shall have the right to designate the diversion site as the home school for the student's siblings.
