







[LEA Submission] Teachers at The Academy of Alameda engage in extensive professional learning. In addition to 15 days of full day professional development (PD) throughout the year, the teaching staff meets for two hours of PD every Wednesday, grade level teams meet for collaboration and PD for 45 minutes every week, and teachers periodically attend trainings with outside agencies (eg Eureka Math trainings, Next Generation Science Standard training at the County Office of Education, etc.). The topics covered in professional development include, but are not limited to: implementation of all state standards and curriculum frameworks, use of the standards-aligned curricular materials that the school has chosen, and instructional best practices. The school also has an instructional coach. The instructional coach and school principal meet weekly to identify and plan for the professional learning needs of the teaching staff as well as for the needs of individual teachers. The instructional coach meets weekly with teachers in six week coaching cycles and works collaboratively with them to set short term and long term goals, based upon an analysis of their current teaching practices. Through the coaching cycles, the instruction coach provides support for teachers on the standards they have not yet mastered.

[LEA Submission] 1. Seeking input from parent/guardians in school decision making: The Academy's governing board elected a parent to the board. As both a board member and a parent, this person represents the concerns and interests of the families in the school and is an active participant in decision making for the school, at the highest levels. Furthermore, in the development of the school's Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP), the administration sought feedback from the Parent Advisory Committee which met on three separate occasions (11/15/16, 1/17/17, 3/27/17). The PAC reviewed the school's goals, actions and services, assessment data, and budgeted expenditures and gave input on the overall development of the LCAP, which is a document that is closely connected to (and guides) decision making at the school site. 2. Promoting parental participation in programs: Each day at The Academy begins with Morning Read. Morning Read is a time where parents/guardians are invited into their children's classrooms to read with children. Morning Read encourages parental participation in the school's literacy program and gives families a daily opportunity to be involved with the school. Additionally, the school offered several parenting workshops throughout the year on topics such as supporting your child in math, how to set limits and establish routines at home, how to build literacy skills, and having difficult conversations with your child on the topics of race and gender. 3. The measures described above--parent participation on the governing board, the Parent Advisory Committee, Morning Read, and parenting workshops--were chosen because they highlight how well families are integrated into The Academy's daily, weekly, monthly, and annual plans. The measures clearly align and are related to goals that the school established in its LCAP. The school's LCAP has three goals--one of which states the importance of family engagement. The goal is to "have thriving and meaningful parent/family engagement."

[LEA Submission] The Academy of Alameda Elementary School has a safe and secure learning environment for students, staff, and families. On the school's annual Family Satisfaction Survey, Academy families, on average, rated their overall satisfaction with the school as a 4.79 on a 5 point scale. Furthermore, they gave the school a 4.67 for satisfaction with instruction for social-emotional learning and a 4.71 for satisfaction with the school culture (both on a 5 point scale). Academy families' high degree of satisfaction in all of these areas indicates their strong belief in the safety and security of the school's climate and the positive effect that climate has on their children. Staff at The Academy rated their overall satisfaction with their jobs as 4.2, satisfaction with the climate of the school as 4.3, and safety of the work environment as 4.4 (all of which are on a 5 point scale). The staff's overwhelmingly positive responses on all three questions indicates that they feel the school has a healthy and positive school culture that supports student learning. The school maintained an average daily attendance of 96% and had zero suspensions or expulsions. The high daily attendance rate suggests that students and families feel safe and connected to the school; the climate is welcoming and students are excited to come to school each day. Zero suspensions and expulsions indicates that the school climate is supportive and sufficiently addresses the needs of its students. All of the aforementioned measures were shared with the school's local governing board at a regularly scheduled meeting, and the data was included as a part of the school's Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP). Development of the LCAP included a variety of stakeholders from teaching staff to parents, and the completed LCAP--along the with aforementioned data--was shared at a regularly scheduled meeting of the school's Family Alliance.

Additional Comments (Optional Box Completed by The Academy of Alameda Elementary)

[LEA Submission] For the 2016-17 school year, The Academy of Alameda Elementary School served students in grades kindergarten through second grade. As such, administering a survey such as the California Healthy Kids survey was impossible. Thus, the school relied on questions from the parent survey and the staff survey, attendance rates, and suspension and expulsion rates to determine that criteria for Priority 6 had been met.
